Around \$10 round trip - depart from **Pier 41** 9:45 AM - arrive 10:10 AM - meet at 11 AM at the Cove Café - about 300 ft from the "gift shop", now known as the Information Station; the Cove Café - buy shuttle bus tickets and catches the bus to US Immigration Station - bring a sack lunch. Depart Angel Island on the 3:50 PM - arrive San Francisco Pier 41 at 4:20 PM.

Alcatraz Night Tour - depart from **Pier 33** at **5:55 PM** - 10 minute ferry ride, 2 hr 40 minute tour, there is also a 6:30 PM departure in case the tickets get sold out for the first departure.

Call for posters:

1). People doing their own thing -- anything: pictures, documents, family trees, articles.

-- Email each photo separately to Mel at melyoung88@earthlink.net by 7/15/17.

-- Keep size down (150 kb or less) so Mel's inbox doesn't get overloaded

-- In the subject line, write your name + a VERY SHORT description so Mel can file the picture properly.

-- Mel will print the photos in 4x6 form and mount them on 4x6 index cards with 2" of blank white space at the bottom. At the conference, you will get your mounted photos back. You can then handwrite a full description of your photo on the index card portion. Mel will take those photos and mount them on black poster board for viewing the next day.
