The mission of the Chinese Historical Society of Southern California (CHSSC) is to bring together people with a mutual interest in the important history and historical role of Chinese and Chinese Americans in southern California. We pursue, preserve, and communicate knowledge of this history, and promote the heritage of the Chinese and Chinese American community in support of a better appreciation of the rich, multicultural society of the United States.

POSITION OBJECTIVE

This internship provides hands on experience in the field of Asian American community history. During this ten-week summer position, the intern will gain experience conducting and transcribing oral histories, working on remote archival historical research, while developing related community-engaged research skills through a focus on the history of Chinese Americans in Los Angeles. The intern will work in part on the CHSSC's Five Chinatowns project, which documents the history of Old Chinatown, New Chinatown, China City, City Market, and the East Adams neighborhood Los Angeles in the period before 1965. The successful candidate will possess strong administrative skills, should be familiar with basic historic research techniques, have a general understanding of Asian American history, and have excellent oral and written communication skills. This internship is made possible by the dedicated CHSSC volunteers and generous donors.
